Famous sites and monuments from Roman-era ruins to post-World War II memorials are essential keys to understanding the French culture and its heritage.



The Louvre Museum

•It serves as a testament to its rich history spanning the medieval period to the present. The Louvre Museum is one of the most famous art museums in the world, known for the iconic glass pyramid at its entrance. See the most famous painting *Mona Lisa* and be mesmerized by the adjacent Jardin des Tuileries.

Fragonard Perfume Museum

•It welcomes the students for a guided tour unveiling the manufacturing secrets of perfume and its extraordinary history from Antiquity to the present day. Founded in 1926, Maison Fragonard is a family business boasting unique traditional French expertise.





Eiffel Tower

•The world-famous metallic tower was built for the Paris International Exhibition in 1889 for the centenary of the French Revolution. At the time of its inauguration, it was the world's tallest monument. The students will be mesmerized with the breathtaking panoramic view from this world wonder.

Montmartre and Sacré Coeur

- •Visible from many parts of Paris, the basilica of Sacré-Cœur stands like a whipped-cream church atop the hill of Montmartre.
- •A visit to the nearby Place du Tertre is an amazing experience where artists sketch and paint and you can have your portrait painted.

•Discover Paris Story, a incredible film that will take you on an astonishing journey through the history of the world's loveliest city. For nearly an hour you are whirled through the history of Paris, along the centuries from the founding of the Gallo-Roman settlement of Lutetia to the present day.

Paris is a city with a rich history that dates back to the 3rd century B.C. The monuments and attractions are breath-taking and varied in terms of period and architectural style.



Palace of Versailles and its Gardens

•A symbol of the French monarchy, the Chateau de Versailles was erected by the powerful "Sun King" Louis XIV, then later was home to Louis XVI and Marie Antoinette. Witness royal architecture of the palace, including the emblematic Hall of Mirrors and get an amusing perspective on royal life at the palace. The palace's gardens are lush, scenic and idyllic.

Notre Dame

- •Dating to the 12th century, the Notre-Dame Cathedral with its intricate architectural details will charm the students. This landmark has become synonymous with Parisian religion.
- •The Cathedral of Notre-Dame is a jewel of Gothic architecture and arguably one of the finest churches in Europe.





Arc de triomphe and Champs Elysées

•The Arc de Triomphe is an icon of imperial France under Napoleon I. The Arc de Triomphe is a monumental triumphal arch that sits at the top of the prestigious Avenue of Champs-Élysées.

Boat cruise on Seine River

•A classic river boat cruise - a large, flat bottom boat with an open top, from which the students can see the amazing views of the famous buildings along the Seine.





Disneyland Paris


